Dementia Awareness, Detection and Support

Overview

Dementia is a major health and social challenge for ageing societies, with the number of people living with **dementia in Malaysia expected to rise substantially**. Advances in biomarkers, digital technologies, and disease-modifying therapies are transforming dementia care, creating an urgent need for healthcare professionals, community organisations, and the public to be **better prepared for earlier detection** and **more effective intervention**.

This interactive workshop provides a practical understanding of dementia, including how to **distinguish normal ageing from cognitive impairment, recognise early warning signs**, and **explore opportunities for risk reduction and early intervention**. The session also highlights the **role of allied health professionals**, healthy ageing advocates, caregivers, and communities in supporting people **living with dementia**.
